

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-01

An Ordinance amending Chapter 10 of the Hope Town Code

Whereas, the Hope Town Council has reviewed the Hope Town Code and has determined that Chapter 10, Article 3 "Zoning Ordinance", Section 10-22 should be amended;

Now therefore, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Hope, Indiana:

1. That Chapter 10, Article 3 "Zoning Ordinance", Section 10-22 "Definitions" 8.035 "Animals" is hereby amended to read as follows:

8-035 Animals


Animal, Domestic: Dogs, cats, parakeets, finches, spiders, guinea pigs, hamsters, gerbils, rats, mice, rabbits, aquarium fish, ferrets, and snakes used and cared for as household pets, companions, or for the assistance of disabled persons.

Animal, Farm: Horses, cattle, pigs, sheep, goats, mules, donkeys, camels, emus, ostrich, lamas, alpacas, mink, fox, bison, chickens, turkeys, quail, pheasants, and other animals or fowl of similar characteristics and any miniature versions thereof.

The Council further finds that due to the prior uncertainty of the ordinance, Mr. Tim Saylor is permitted to keep no more than 11 chickens in good condition on his property.

This Ordinance is hereby passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Hope, Indiana, this 16th day of Feb, 2016.
