RESOLUTION

TOWN OF HOPE GROUP HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, employees covered under the Town of Hope's group health insurance program obtain Medicare insurance coverage upon the attainment of age 65, in addition to the Town of Hope's program.

AND WHEREAS, Medicare has deductible and out of pocket expenses that can be covered by Medicare Supplement Insurance.


AND WHEREAS, it would be mutually advantageous for such individuals and the Town of Hope for these individuals to waive their group health coverage in lieu of Medicare and a Medicare Supplement Insurance policy.

AND WHEREAS, waiving group health coverage would result in the elimination of prescription drug coverage.

NOW THEREFORE, it is resolved that the Town of Hope agrees to pay the Medicare Supplement Insurance premium(s) and Part D prescription drug premium(s) for such individuals and their eligible dependents, as long as they are full time employees, otherwise eligible for the Town of Hope's group health program.

Effective April 1, 2017.




