

**ORDINANCE 2022-11**

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE  
OPIOID SETTLEMENT RESTRICTED FUND (2257)**

**WHEREAS**, Indiana Code 4-6-15 addresses opioid litigation and settlements; and,

**WHEREAS**, Indiana was part of the \$26 billion national settlement with Johnson and Johnson, AmerisourceBergen, Cardinal Health, and McKesson; and,

**WHEREAS**, Indiana's share of the settlement was approximately \$507 million with all cities, town, and counties in the state participating in the settlement; and,


**WHEREAS**, the Town of Hope expects to receive approximately \$6,547.89 in restricted funds from the settlement over the next approximately eighteen (18) years; and,


**WHEREAS**, the Indiana State Board of Accounts has stated these monies are to be accounted for in a separate fund; now, therefore, be it


**ORDAINED**, by the Town Council of the Town of Hope, Bartholomew County, Indiana, that the Opioid Settlement Restricted Fund 2257 is created to account for the restricted portion of the settlement distribution which is to be used only for those things listed on the *List of Opioid Remediation Uses*.


